Great news — now you can get a **\$500 rebate** for all new solar installations with an In Service date from September 1, 2024 through April 30, 2026. Installations must also be completed by a qualified solar contractor. To make the process as convenient as possible, your solar contractor can even submit the rebate on your behalf.

Benefits

Eligibility

Every solar project goes through a similar step-by-step process. The following eligibility requirements must be met to qualify:

- ✓ Your Interconnection Application must be completed and approved. If not, visit peco.com/solar to get started.
- ✓ Installation details for each solar panel must be completed.
- ✓ Solar panels must be installed at a residence that currently receives PECO residential electric service.
- ✓ Solar rebate will only be paid for approved interconnection applications with an In Service date from September 1, 2024 through April 30, 2026.
- ✓ If the rebate application is approved, you should receive your \$500 rebate check within 4–6 weeks, after the “In Service” status.



Combine tax credits with \$500 solar rebates

Did you know you can also combine eligible tax credits with the PECO solar rebate?

The federal residential solar energy credit is a tax credit that can be claimed on federal income taxes for a percentage of the cost of a solar PV system paid for by the taxpayer. The installation of the system must be completed **during the tax year**.
